Our speakers this evening are Dr. Dan Van Syoc and Jane Hill, project leaders for Rotary's Alzheimer's Research Project, which was launched on May 21, 2024. This project is sponsored by the Rotary Club of San Antonio West.



They describe their personal stories to raise awareness and funds for the Biggs Institute for Alzheimer's and Neurodegenerative Diseases at UT Health San Antonio. It has been determined that one out of three people age 85 or older will suffer from some form of dementia and Alzheimer's is currently the 7th leading cause of death.

The objective of this project are:

- Provide funding for research projects that address the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of Alzheimer's disease, emphasizing young researchers and promising research projects in their preliminary stages.
- Raise awareness and advocacy for Alzheimer's research among other Rotary Club members, stakeholders, and the public.
- Raise awareness of the Biggs Institute for Alzheimer's and Neurodegenerative Diseases at UT Health San Antonio, one of 33 nationwide centers and the only one in Texas recognized as a National Institute on Aging-designated Alzheimer's Research Center.
- Build and strengthen the partnership between Rotary Club West and the Glenn Biggs Institute for Alzheimer's and Neurodegenerative Diseases at UT Health San Antonio.
- Establish and maximize relationships with organizations within Rotary and external to Rotary with shared common objectives.
