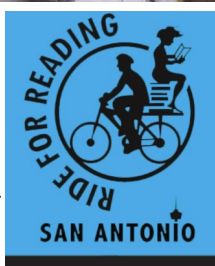
Rotary's Four Way Test of the things we think, say or do:

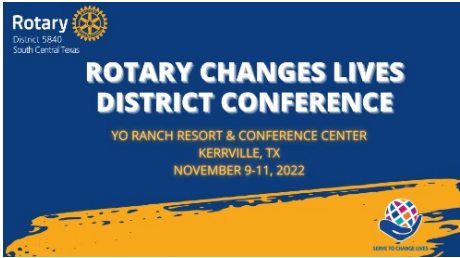


Interact clubs bring together young people ages 12-18 to develop leadership skills while discovering the power of **Service Above Self**.
