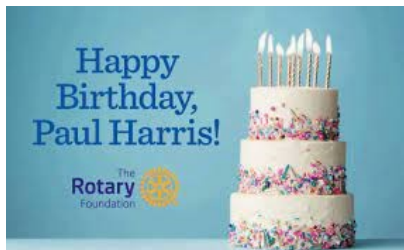

Bob and Celeste Barron will be celebrating their wedding anniversary on May 1st. Happy Anniversary Bob and Celeste.

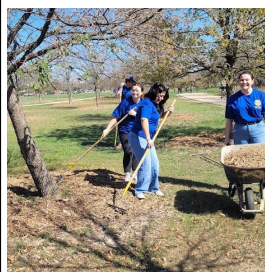
And finally one special birthday to share. On April 19, 1868, Paul Harris, the founder of Rotary was born.
